GDS-Movement envisions thriving places and communities activated by regenerative tourism and events. Our mission is to empower people with the mindsets, skill sets, and toolsets to create regenerative destinations to visit, meet, and live in.

About GDS-Index, GDS-Forum, and GDS-Awards

<u>GDS-Index</u> is a measurement and management tool for destinations keen to contribute to the social, environmental, and economic well-being of people, place, and planet through tourism and events. It helps co-create more sustainable destinations by assessing, benchmarking, consulting to, and communicating about participating destinations' sustainability contributions. Destinations are assessed annually, and ranked.

<u>GDS-Forum</u> convenes and unites destination management professionals to catalyse innovation for regeneration and transform tourism from the inside. Its inaugural instance, "Co-Creating Destination Positive", was held in Valencia, Spain, 3 – 4 October 2023, as part of a collaborative journey for committed and passionate industry professionals, brought to you by <u>CityDNA</u>, <u>VISIT VALÈNCIA</u>, and <u>Global Destination Sustainability Movement</u> (GDS-Movement). It includes the 2023 <u>GDS-Awards</u> ceremony, which was, this year, hosted with our long-time partner, <u>ICCA</u>, on 4 October, and followed by the CityDNA <u>Autumn Conference 2023</u>, "Building Blocks for Destination Positive", 4 – 7 October.

Each year, GDS-Movement celebrates destination sustainability efforts in the annual <u>GDS-Awards</u>. This year, it announces the winners of the Leadership, Most Improved Destination (both based on GDS-Index data), as well as the Innovation and the new GDS-Movement and <u>#Meet4Impact</u> Impact award (both based on criteria judged by external experts).
